Other Business	<ul> <li>Spirit Wear Campaign</li> <li>Orders are due on Friday, November 10.</li> <li>So far, we have received 45 orders for 73 pieces, raising about \$355.</li> <li>The most popular item so far is the Pull Over Hoodie, second is Short Sleeve Tee, followed closely by the Embroidered Full Zip Hoodie.</li> <li>Purdys Chocolates</li> <li>So far there has been \$1000 in sales, 12 days left.</li> <li>Chocolates will be delivered to the school, between November 24th and 29th.</li> <li>Orders will be sorted and available for pickup at school.</li> <li>Neufeld's Farm Market</li> <li>Registered and link is available and active until November 26.</li> <li>Pickup is December 4, 4 pm.</li> <li>Family Skate</li> <li>Thursday, December 21, 5pm to 6:30pm</li> <li>Check on later time slot for next year.</li> <li>Movie Nights</li> <li>\$400 per year for AFC license to show movies (including Disney and Pixar).</li> <li>Other schools have collected by donation, selling tickets in advance, or tickets at the door.
