Are there rules on how much funds we are allowed to reserve for a future project or if there's an amount we are allowed to have left over? <p><i>Ivy reached out to DPAC and the response was there is no set minimum amount that PACs are required to maintain in the general account, it's recommended Pacs keep a reasonable reserve to cover ongoing operating expenses and any unexpected costs that may arise.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">It is likely that we can apply for a grant to support this project. The application period would be between September and October, and we would expect to hear back by the end of the year. Prior to applying, we should ensure our finances are in order. If approved, the track would not begin until 2027.From looking at the account, the projected surplus for this school year is going to be \$30,098.93Gallit spoke to Steve from the district regarding this project, if the city agrees to share the cost with us, it is estimated that our portion would be around \$40,000
