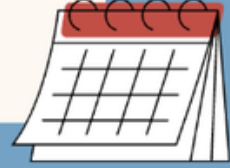

ON SUNNY DAYS

Go on Outdoor Adventures!

- Nature Scavenger Hunt: Search for specific leaves, rocks, or bugs in the neighborhood.
- Gardening: Plant flowers or start a vegetable garden.
- Active Games: Play tag, soccer, or other ball games outside! visit a new playground together!
- Driveway Art: Use sidewalk chalk to create a town or a complex obstacle course.
- Nature Crafting: Paint rocks or create bird feeders.

Tips for Success

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- ✓ Rotate Activities: Avoid overloading on too many activities; switch between indoor and outdoor, active and quiet.
- ✓ Model the Behavior: Parents can join in, reducing their own screen time to engage with kids.
- ✓ Follow a Routine: Keep a loose schedule with morning, afternoon, and evening themes.

ON RAINY DAYS

- Build a Blanket Fort: Use cushions, blankets, and chairs to create a cozy hideaway.
- Cardboard Creations: Turn recycled boxes into castles, boats, or race tracks.
- Science Lab: Make homemade slime or baking soda volcanoes.
- Talent Show/Show: Put on a living room talent show or puppet show.



QUIET ACTIVITIES

- Board Games & Puzzles: Family tournaments with games like Go Fish.
- Reading Corner: Visit the local library to pick out new books.
- Baking & Cooking: Let kids help make lunch or bake cookies/muffins/etc
- Journaling/Writing: Encourage kids to write and illustrate their own 20-page book.
- Audiobooks/Podcasts: Listen to stories together during quiet time.

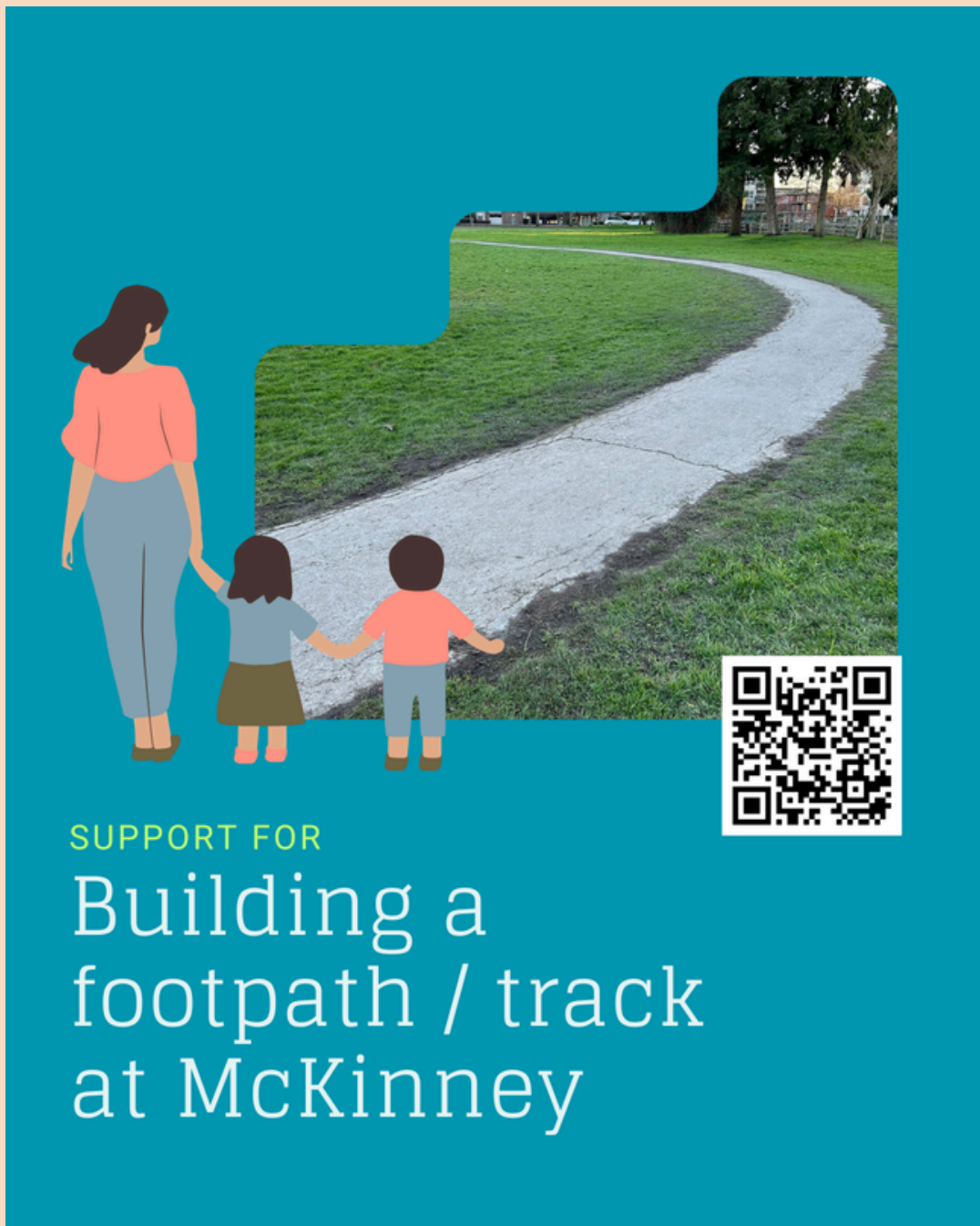
